The food pantry volunteers would like to thank all those who have helped the food pantry this year. Your prayers, service and donations make it possible for us to share Christ's blessings with many in our church and community. Your continued support is greatly appreciated.

The Food Pantry workers made many trips to the Food Bank, Rice Depot, Allen Canning, Little Debbie and other resources. Through your donations and the hard work of our volunteers we brought in **148,794 pounds** of food (and related items). The Food Pantry served **16,592 people** with food boxes that would provide them with 4-5 complete meals and various snacks. It has been a pleasure serving people from our church and community, sharing Christ's love with them and helping them feed their families.

ENJOY A GOOD MYSTERY?

If so, then the Good Shepherd Class begins a new study December 8 you will like - "Detective Stories from the Bible" by J. Ellsworth Kalas. The Bible contains some detective stories, but they might best be called "life mysteries." These stories are not all mystery stories in the conventional sense of the word, but they investigate incidents, personalities, and topics that ought to catch the interest of anyone with a detective's turn of mind. For example, the Bible has a lot to say about blood. Why is this so important, and how far back, biblically, does this theme go? Cain was warned that the ground would no longer yield for him because he had killed his brother; is there a spiritual connection between our moral conduct and the welfare of this earth? What could be more of a mystery than God's love for the human race? How about a biography of Satan - our adversary?
