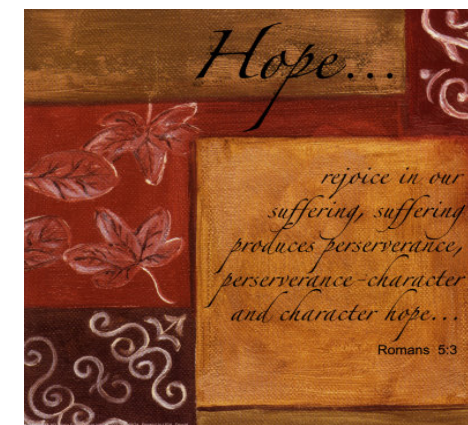

FLU SHOT SUNDAY

Our local Walgreen's Pharmacy is sponsoring a flu vaccination clinic at Heritage this Sunday, October 28th from 9 am - 12 noon. Stop by the Welcome Center and get yourself ready for the flu season. Bring your insurance card; but if you don't have one, come anyway!

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) now recommends a flu vaccine for everyone 6 months of age and older (instead of just certain groups, as was recommended before). But it's especially important that those in higher-risk groups get vaccinated. They include:

- all kids 6 months through 4 years old
- anyone 65 years and older
- women who will be pregnant during flu season
- anyone whose immune system is weakened from medications or illnesses
- any adult or child with chronic medical conditions, such as asthma.
- kids or teens who take aspirin regularly and are at risk for developing Reye syndrome if they get the flu
- health care personnel who have direct contact with patients caregivers or household contacts of anyone in a high-risk group (like children younger than 6 months)

Certain circumstances would prevent a person from getting the vaccine. If you fall into any of the groups below, talk to your doctor to see if the vaccine is still recommended:

- infants under 6 months old
- anyone who's severely allergic to eggs and egg products. (People with a mild egg allergy can receive the vaccine, but it should be given in a doctor's office so that they can be monitored for side effects for 30 minutes after the shot is given.)
- anyone who's ever had a severe reaction to a flu vaccination
- anyone with Guillain-Barré syndrome (a rare condition that affects the immune system and nerves)

PRAYER BOOTH BLESSES MANY

How does one judge success when offering prayer to others at a fall festival? Is it by the number of people that voluntarily stop by to ask for prayer, or is it by the total number of prayer requests? I am not totally sure of the answer, but I believe success is surely judged by the people whose hearts are touched by the prayers received and those touched by giving the prayers. Many people are desperate for intervention from God. Their woes and concerns are serious; they want someone to intervene. This year's requests were no exception. We had -150 people request prayer for themselves, friends, family, and our country. We had many requests for healing from cancer, for employment, for marriages, for addictions, for safety for troops, and various health problems. We had some people request prayers for salvation. Some specific requests involved a lady who had just been diagnosed with breast cancer, a very small girl who had extreme scoliosis and was facing back surgery, a lady who had trouble with pain in her feet, a Vietnam vet who is struggling with caring for his elderly mom and with following God's path for himself. I remember two young children who asked for prayers for a mom and an uncle, and teens who asked for prayers for their friends. One lady said her sister would die within a few days unless she is delivered from drug addiction. Another lady asked for prayers for reconciliation with her siblings. She had been estranged from them for 20-30 years, but had recently seen them again.

Thanks to all who took the time to staff the prayer booth, and to all of you who took prayer requests to pray over the following week. I believe we were all blessed by the opportunity to lift up the requests to the Lord. I was especially impressed with the boldness and love of T. J., our young teen, who seemed to love praying for others. Maybe we will have more youth involved next year??
