IN REMEMBRANCE




Elmo M. Evans, C.L.U. 83 of Van Buren passed away Wednesday, January 02, 2013 in a local hospital. He was a manager for Metropolitan Life Insurance Company for over 30 years and a member of Heritage United Methodist Church. He was preceded in death by his wife, Diane Brocchus Evans, a son, Gaylon Evans and a daughter-in-law Marilyn Evans.

He is survived by his three sons, Brian & Mark Evans both of Van Buren, Chris Evans of Bryant; two sisters, Armeda Holmes of Van Buren, Angie Benham of Rogers; eleven grandchildren and seven great grandchildren.

The name of our church, Heritage, certainly fits Elmo. His parents were members of St. John's (one of the two merging churches that formed Heritage) all their lives and so was Elmo. He grew up just a few blocks from the church and he and Diane, except for a few years when his job took them out of state, made their home just down the street. Their four boys were raised at St. John's and now that heritage is being passed down through Mark and Julie to their two sons. When the merger was proposed in the fall of 1984, Elmo was elected to serve on the merger study committee. Because of his long family ties with St. John's, it was a very difficult decision for him to make, but Elmo felt that the two churches could do much more together than they could separately. After the merger was approved, he served on the building committee to plan and oversee construction of our present facilities. He was very faithful in attending and participating with both committees and his keen business sense was a valuable asset. Elmo felt strongly that the new building needed a baptistry; he felt people should not have to borrow one from another church if they wanted to be immersed. He was disappointed when that had to be eliminated as part of construction cost cuts and was pleased when our portable baptistry was purchased later with memorial funds. As Heritage grew, Elmo felt that we needed a large Family Life Center. Accordingly, the family asks that memorials be given to the Family Life Center. These memorials will be used for our future multi-purpose building.
