# FROM YOUR PASTOR'S HEART ... "Becoming the Church of God's Dreams ..." Faith that prays for and expects miracles!

The vision the LORD gave us for Heritage back in 2001 was "Becoming the Church of God's Dreams!" This takes the focus off of ourselves -- our wants, preferences and desires - and puts the focus properly on the LORD and HIS desires! The LORD gave us seven elements of that vision from Acts 2 and 4 on which to focus:

Teaching that is Life-Changing.

Fellowship that goes well below the surface.

Love that is like Christ's – self-sacrificial.

Faith that prays for and expects miracles.

Sharing and Serving that is extravagant.

Worship that is joyful, reverent, and engaging.

Team that seeks and saves the lost.

This week Jesus is teaching us about element number four: **faith that prays for and expects miracles.** In Acts 2:42-43, Dr. Luke says that the early believers "dedicated themselves … to prayer. Then awe/fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles." Soon afterwards, the Holy Spirit was doing the same through the deacons and later through other ordinary believers.



In Luke 18:1-8 Jesus tells a parable "that people should always pray and not lose heart." After the story, Jesus asks, "When the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?" This week we are going to study **How to Pray and Not Lose Heart!** We are going to look at how we can pray in such a way to build ourselves up and strengthen ourselves for whatever the days ahead bring!
