RESURRECTION CELEBRATION

CHILDREN'S MINISTRY PRESENTS "WALK WITH JESUS"

This powerful multisensory event guides children through Jesus' last days on earth. Each station is set up for powerful teaching with engaging activities for children three years old through fifth grade. The children will travel from Palm Sunday in Jerusalem to a sit down Last Supper, then to pray in the Garden of Gethsemane and discover the sacrifice of Good Friday to the celebration of the empty tomb!

This occurs at all three services on Easter Sunday. Our check-in system will be different for this special event. TRANSITIONS



I have asked Pastor Wes and Roger for one thing...to spare me from standing in front of the congregation. You who know me, know that is something I definitely do not enjoy. As a compromise with Allison, I agreed to write something for the Newsletter.

I have always assumed I would work until I died. Retirement for me was not something to look forward to, but something to dread. Work gave me income, but the real thing it gave me was busyness. I told myself I was too busy to seek God, to listen for His sweet voice, to look at my actions and the effect they have on the world around me, to deal with my flesh. Work became a place where I hid from God. I cringed at the thought of having lots of time on my hands to do whatever I wanted. I wanted to work, to stay busy so I didn't have to change. I was comfortable with where I was, not with who I am, but because I was busy working, I did

not have time to deal with my lack of prayer, lack of time with God, with who I was. My time with God was a conversation in my head, a few minutes of prayer in the morning or during prayer times at church. I knew my life was out of order but I did nothing to change the situation. Then at the insistence of my husband I decided it was time to retire. By the time I actually retired, thanks be to my loving God, I was ready. It has only been a few weeks and already my relationship with God has grown exponentially. The last years of my life will not be wasted; just the opposite, they will be glorious because God is directing my steps and He knows the future and works all things together for good (not just for us but for the world) for those that love Him and are called according to His purposes (Romans 8:28).

The verses God gave me on March 17th were Jeremiah 9:23-24 "Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the strong man glory in his strength, let not the rich man glory in his wealth, but let him who glories, glory in this that he understands and knows Me, that I am the Lord who exercises lovingkindness, justice and righteousness on earth, for I delight in these things," declares the Lord.

During the moments I have sought the Lord, the cry of my heart has been to seek Him with my whole heart. These verses, which I am unable to tell you how He led me to them, are changing me from the inside out. I no longer read God's Word to know what happened, I read it to 'understand and know' my Lord. That shift in my perspective is life changing. The initial calling from God as an intercessor has been rekindled.

The years working in the office have been happy years. I was blessed to get to know so many of you that I probably might never have by just attending church with you. I thank each of you for allowing me to serve in the position of financial secretary. Where I have failed you and God, I humbly ask for forgiveness. I leave with an excitement for where Heritage is going. Growth for the Kingdom is happening at Heritage. If I had ever doubted that, the wonder of the qualifications of our new Financial Manager would dispel the doubt. Lisa Willis is so over qualified, as others on staff are for the positions they hold. But it is not just her education and life experience, it is her heart for the Lord. God has put together a phenomenal staff at Heritage to accomplish His will.

We have what we need to move forward at Heritage and I will be doing what God has called me to – interceding day and night for my family of believers. I humbly thank you for allowing me to serve God and you.
