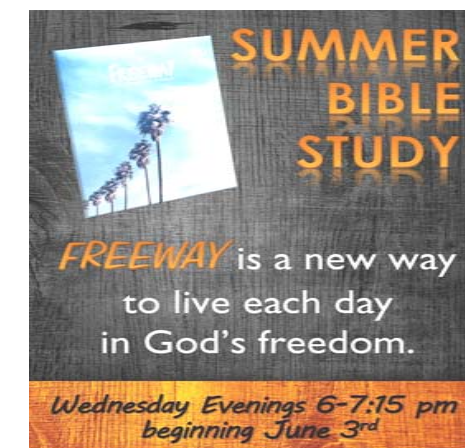
WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

Celebrating 175 years of witnessing in the River Valley and 30 years as Heritage UMC!

One Hundred seventy five years ago a Methodist circuit rider appeared in this area even before Van Buren became a town, preaching under the trees to the trappers, stragglers, the few settlers and the "wildmen"! And 30 years ago on May 5, 1985 Heritage was formed by the merger of two Van Buren churches: 1st and St. John's. The celebration date is Sunday, August 30 at both morning worship and evening fun time.
