

The penitent's heart was so filled with a sense of the wrong done to the Lord himself, that all other confession was swallowed up in a broken hearted acknowledgment of offence against him."



As we continue our FREEWAY journey this Sunday on OWNERSHIP and the power of healing through personal responsibility; I encourage everyone to read the 51st chapter of Psalms and prayerfully request as King David did of the Lord to, "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from Your presence or take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the Joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me."
