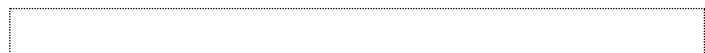

Born into a conservative Jewish household in Brooklyn, NY, Jack found *Yeshua* as his Messiah when his wife Sandi shared the Messianic Prophecies of the Old Testament (*Tenakh*) with him. They now lead the Tree of Life Congregation in Scottsdale, Arizona. He is a former stand-up comedian and has an engaging wit and dynamic speaking style.
