INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH



On September 23rd, after stating their names and where they were from, three Assyrian Christians wearing orange jumpsuits were shot in the back of the head as they knelt in the desert sand. Before stating their name, each hostage said "I am Nasrani," a derogatory Muslim term for Christians.

Zhao Weiliang and Cheng Hongpeng, along with 20 other Christians were singing hymns in a rural factory, when the building was raided by police on June 25, 2014. Pastors Zhao and Cheng were sentenced in May 2015 to four years' imprisonment and three years' imprisonment, respectively.

Arsonists used gasoline as an accelerant to ensure that seven churches in northwestern Tanzania were destroyed in attacks on Sept. 22 and Sept. 27.

Events like this are repeated around the world every day. It is not a new phenomenon; Godly men and women have been persecuted throughout history. Jesus told His disciples that they would be persecuted as He was persecuted. This Sunday is the International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church. Will you join us in prayer for our brothers and sisters worldwide? I am Nasrani—are you?
