FROM YOUR PASTOR'S HEART ... HALLELUJAH! ... SHRED THE MORTGAGE!



We are going to have a great celebration this Sunday! Instead of burning the mortgage and catching people on fire or setting off fire alarms, Mr. Alan Swaim, our Finance Chair, is recommending we **shred** the mortgage! That sounds great to me! It is multiple pages long so we'll shred a page or two each service with some testimonies by children, youth and parents about what our Student Life Center means to them! Afterward, we will formally dedicate the building to the LORD!

Since 2007 we have paid around \$4 million dollars for 18 ½ acres of additional land, site preparation and drainage for all four of our building phases, the completed Student Life Center, and over 220 new parking places. Thank you for your faithfulness in giving above and beyond!

On March 15th, 2015, we began our **Here and Now: Fueling the Fire for the Future** capital campaign. We have paid off the current mortgage in less than a year and now we ask you to continue giving to **Here and Now** as we save toward our next building phase. If you are not currently giving to the **Here and Now** campaign and would like to, we will have cards available in the pews this Sunday.

Please be in prayer for our Trustees/Building Team as they seek to discern what we should do for our next project. We want to hear from you! We have three opportunities coming up in the next two weeks to hear from our architect, Mark Evans, and share with him and our team your input about the needs of the community and the congregation and what this next building should include. Those three opportunities are

- 1) Young at Heart Potluck, Thursday, February 18th, 6 p.m. in the Heritage Fellowship Hall. This is for those 55 and older.
- 2) Heritage Town Hall Meeting, Sunday, February 28th, 3 p.m. in the Heritage Fellowship Hall. This is for anyone.
- 3) Do Good For Nothing Sunday school class, Sunday, February 21st, 11 a.m. in the Community Room. This is for anyone.

We hope you'll attend one of these if possible. Once Mark has this input, he will go back to the drawing board and present his preliminary recommendations to us in April. It is an exciting time!

If there is any way you can come to our **Accountable Covenant Discipleship Workshop** on Saturday, February 27th, I would be so blessed! We are going to have to be prepared to care for and equip the disciples God is sending us so we can **steward the Great Awakening** God is sending! I know you will do your part! You'll never be more alive than when you are doing the ministry God created you to do!

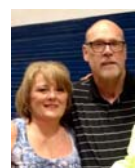
COVENANT DISCIPLESHIP WORKSHOP
