FROM YOUR PASTOR'S HEART ... THE COST OF DISCIPLESHIP

Dr. Charles Armour hit a home run last Sunday with his message on Mark 8:1-26. This Sunday, we hit the **pivot point** of Mark's Gospel when Peter confesses who Jesus is, *"You are the Christ/Messiah!"* The Gospel writer, Matthew, includes Peter saying, *"the Son of the living God"* (Matt. 16:16). Immediately after this, Jesus begins teaching the crowds that He must suffer, be rejected, be killed, and rise again after three days. Peter could not take this, so he takes Jesus aside and begins to rebuke him. But Jesus rebuked Peter and gave the most profound statement in the Bible of what it

means to follow Jesus, *"Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me"* (Mark 8:34). This is the cost of discipleship ... but He is worth it!

Join us Sunday as we discover what **Living as Followers** really means. We will look at the lives of some brothers and sisters who have done this well through the ages!
