# SERIES: THE WEARY WORLD REJOICES MESSAGE: A THRILL OF HOPE! December 1, 2024, Heritage Church, VB, AR TEXTS Psalm 130, Luke 2:36-40

**Isaiah 7:13-14** "Hear then, O house of David! Is it too little for you to **weary** men, that you **weary** my God also? Therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name **Immanuel.** 

BIG IDEA: HOW DO YOU ENDURE THE DEPTHS OF WEARINESS?

### 1. CRY OUT TO THE LORD FOR MERCY

**Psalm 130: 1-4** Out of the depths I **cry** to you, O Lord! <sup>2</sup> O Lord, hear my voice! Let your ears be attentive to the voice of my pleas for **mercy!** <sup>3</sup> If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? <sup>4</sup> But with you there is **forgiveness**, that you may be feared (revered).

## 2. WAIT FOR THE LORD EXPECTANTLY

**Psalm 130:5-6** <sup>5</sup> I wait for the Lord, my soul **waits**, and **in his word** I hope; <sup>6</sup> my soul **waits** for the Lord <u>more than watchmen</u> for the morning, more than watchmen for the morning.

See Luke 2:21-40 Simeon and Anna

### 3. PUT YOUR HOPE IN THE LORD

**Psalm 130: 7-8** <sup>7</sup> O Israel, **hope in the Lord!** For with the Lord there is **steadfast love**, and with him is **plentiful redemption**.

<sup>8</sup> And he will redeem Israel from all his iniquities.

**Hebrews 1:2-3a** <sup>2</sup> ... in these last days God has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. <sup>3</sup> He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power.

**Isaiah 40:30-31** Even youths shall faint and be **weary**, and young men shall fall exhausted; but they who **wait (in hope)** for the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles; they shall run and not be **weary**; they shall walk and not faint.

A. What is the <u>Ground</u> of this Hope? God's <u>CHARACTER</u>! Steadfast <u>Love</u> ... with plentiful redemption

# B. How do You **Experience** this Hope?

**1 Peter 1:3-4** <sup>3</sup>Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be **born again to a living hope** through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, <sup>4</sup> to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, ... <sup>6</sup>in this you **rejoice! ...** See John 3:16, Romans 8:11.
